**Iowa's Nonpoint Source Management Plan (NPSMP)**

The University of Northern Iowa's Institute for Decision Making (IDM) will be facilitating the development of Iowa's Nonpoint Source Management Plan in coordination with an intra-agency partner group comprised of the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Iowa Department of Agriculture & Land Stewardship, Natural Resource Conservation Service, Iowa State University, and Conservation Districts of Iowa. Iowa LICA has been identified as a stakeholder in this plan and was extended an invitation to get involved in this important process. UNI has identified 8 different categories of stakeholder groups that will be brought to the planning table. Iowa LICA was placed in the Business & Industry group.

### **Erosion Demonstration**

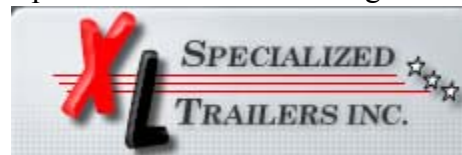
A new Conservation Education Trailer shows erosion processes through short, easy demonstrations. "This trailer gives people a better understanding of long term environmental effects on rivers, streams, and ground water," said Maria Sieck, Pottawattamie County Resource Planner. "It allows us to see a lifetime of change in just a few minutes!" The Conservation Education Trailer has two demonstration units:

1. Stream Table shows riverine processes and channel evolution (such as meandering and channel instability) on an accelerated time scale. This shows us why streams move and teaches how we can stabilize streams and protect water quality.
2. Rainfall Simulator demonstrates how different types of soil cover (such as grass, crop residue, bare soil, etc.) can protect soil from erosion and reduces the amount of sediment in runoff. It teaches the importance of proper ground cover and good soil structure in preserving soil and retaining water quality.

The combination of these two demonstrations at once exhibits a wide range of watershed processes from upland runoff to stream flow.
